Paper Structure

1. Abstract

A concise summary of the entire paper, **maximum 250 words**.

It should include:

- Research objective
- Methodology
- Key findings
- Brief conclusion

Keywords: Include **3–5 keywords** after the abstract.

2. Introduction

Provide a clear overview of:

- Background and context of the research problem
 - Relevance and urgency of the topic
 - Research objectives
 - Problem statement and main contribution
 - Related work or prior research
 - The novelty or differentiating aspect of your study

3. Data

Describe the data sources used in the study.

- If collecting your own data, include:
 - > Data collection method (e.g., interview, survey, observation, experiment)
 - > Location, time, and number of respondents or observation units
 - > Any validation or reliability checks (if applicable)
 - If using benchmark or online datasets, include:
 - > Dataset name
 - > Direct URL
 - > Relevant details such as dataset size, collection year, and key variables

4. Methodology

Explain the analytical approach or techniques used in the study, such as:

- Statistical methods

Writing Tables and Figures

Tables and figures must be numbered sequentially and include clear captions.
Captions for tables should be written above the table. Example:

Ensure that every table or figure included in your paper is mentioned at least once in the body text. Use the following format when referencing:

- > For figures: Based on Fig. 1, the proposed method outperforms...
- > For tables: As shown in Table 2, the dataset consists of...

Ensure all images have sufficient resolution for printing or display.

Use consistent formatting throughout the document for numbering and caption styles.
